Located at 2812 Opryland Drive in Nashville, Tennessee, the General Jackson Showboat is named after President Andrew Jackson, whose historic home—The Hermitage—is 19 minutes from the dock. The showboat was launched in April 1985 and was christened on July 2, 1985. Our 300-foot Paddlewheel Riverboat sits 77 feet tall with a capacity of 1,037 passengers and 135 crew members, making it the largest vessel of its kind in the world.

It boasts four massive decks, a mouthwatering southern-style meal along with dynamic live entertainment in the beautiful two-story Victorian Theater.
