BEHIND THE SCENES

The Ryman Auditorium is one of Nashville's signature historical country music landmarks. Originally built as a tabernacle, it is best known as the "mother church" of country music and was home to the Grand Ole Opry from 1943 to 1974. Take a behind the scenes tour where you will hear the stories about famous artists like Minnie Pearl, Roy Acuff and even the King himself, Elvis Presley, spent some time. Depending on what is going on at the Ryman that day, you may even get to go backstage!

Travel down Broadway for a bite to eat at Rock Bottom Nashville before heading to the Grand Ole Opry House.

No trip to Nashville would be complete without experiencing the phenomenon of the world famous Grand Ole Opry House.
