The morning begins with a stop at the Country Music Hall of Fame. The world's largest research center dedicated to a single form of American music. The museum recently unveiled a \$100 million expansion doubling its size to 350,000 square feet of dynamic state-of-the-art galleries, archival storage, education classrooms, retail stores, and special event spaces. Here guests can get an in-depth look at the people, places and instruments that have contributed to the development of country music.

From there, you will dine at Café Fontanella Italian Kitchen & Wine Bar on grounds of the unique home that Barbara Mandrell built in 1988 in Whites Creek, Tennessee. It was her primary home for years and acted as a gathering place and getaway for countless country music stars. The final stop will be a sampling of wines in the winery or a tasting in the distillery on property.
